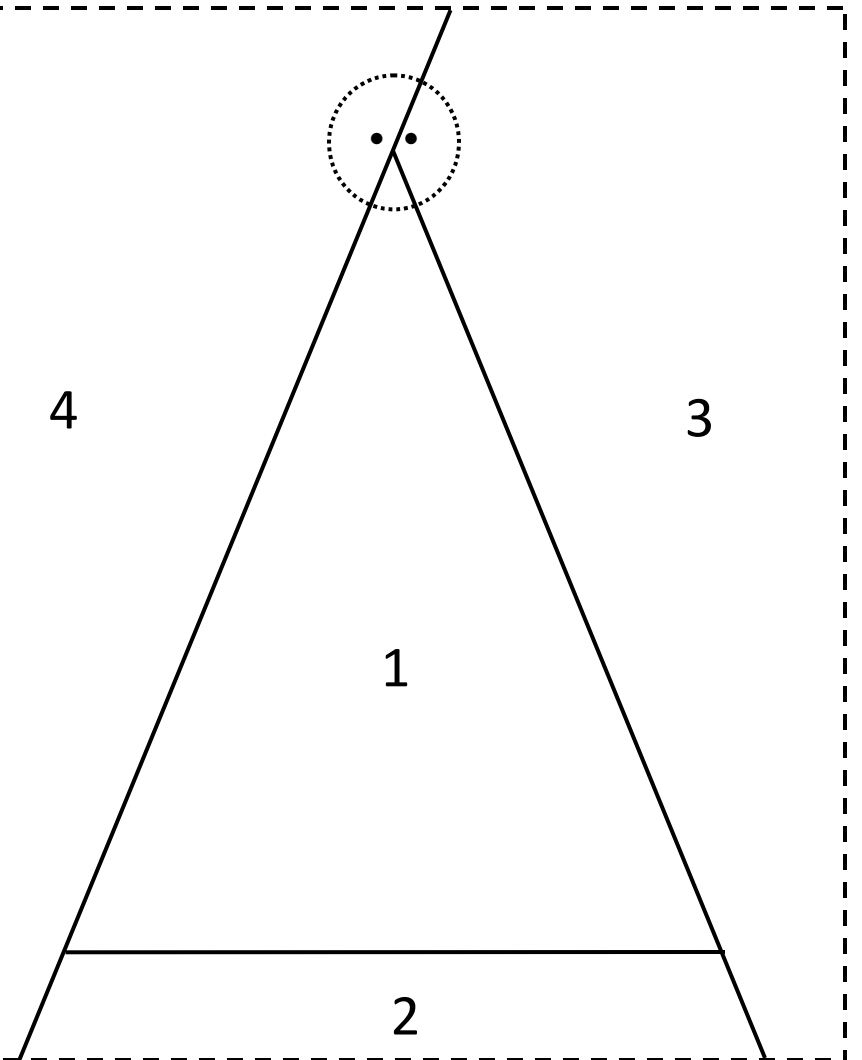
Print Test

## Materials

- 7" Square Green Scrap for Tree Triangle #1
- 7" Square Christmas Print Scrap for Side Block #5
- 1/4 yd for Tree Background and Backing for the mat
- 2 1/4" x 40" Strip for Binding
- 7" x 11" Piece of Batting or Fusible Fleece like Pellon
- Button Embellishment (optional)

## Assembly

1. Print out pattern and paper foundation piece the mug mat.
2. Layer with batting and backing. Add quilting lines as desired.
3. Bind and embellish. Enjoy!

## Recommended cutting guidelines

- #1 - 5" wide by 5 1/2" tall
- #2 - 6" wide by 1 3/4" tall
- #3 and #4 - 3 1/2" wide by 7 3/4" tall
- #5 - 6" wide by 6 3/4" tall
- Backing - 11" wide by 7" tall
- Batting - 11" wide by 7" tall

Kids, age 6-14, ask an adult to help you complete this mug mat. All rotary cutting should be done by an adult. Younger kids can trace the tree triangle shape and fuse it on a 5-1/2" square instead of using the paper piecing method.
